## Sinfra: 40 million medical equipment for health structures

The general hospital and maternal and child health center (PMI) of Sinfra, the rural health centers (CSR) of Huafla, Djénédoufla, and the urban health center (CSU) of Konétinfla received medical equipment from a value of 40 million FCFA. This material, which includes hospital beds, mattresses, walkers, boxes of microscopes etc., is a gift from the former mayor of Sinfra (1990 to 1995), Adama Diop. According to him, this material was collected from his friends living in the United States of America. **" I wanted to do this discreetly, but the American donors were keen to organize a public ceremony so that the national and international opinion is informed of their approach. We spent 5.5 million CFA francs for clearance and other fees** , "he said. Before announcing that his friends have promised to make this type of donation, twice a year. **" We intend to fully and truly equip the Sinfra General Hospital. And given the large amount of donations, we decided to share them with the other health centers in the commune,** "he promised.

This donation, it should be noted, was received by the Prefect of Sinfra, Lacina Fofana on behalf of the Departmental Director of Health and Public Hygiene, Kra Koffi Lazare. On behalf of the health staff, the departmental director made a commitment to make good use of it. As for the Prefect, he hoped that this gesture is a stain in the department. Lacina Fofana also urged the population to solidarity and cohesion.

Mayor Adama Diop of Sinfra commune (Marahoué region), from 1990 to 1995, offered the school group Douafla de Sinfra on Saturday 18 August 2018 large quantities of medical equipment of an estimated value. to 40 million FCFA. This material is intended for the health structures of the municipality to boost the care provided to the population. These beneficiary structures are the general hospital and maternal and child health center (PMI) of Sinfra, the rural health centers (CSR) of Huafla and Djénédoufla, the urban health center (CSU) of Konétinfla. They receive, among other things, emergency, examination and hospital beds; mattresses; gallows; walkers; scales; boxes of microscopes; English canes; seals and baskets; blouses and block suits; bales of sheets and pajamas; pairs of crutches; cartons of suture, insulin syringes, abdominal compresses, tape, plasters, infusers, urinary catheters, mufflers, petrolatum, basins, gloves, thoracolumbar belts, resuscitation equipment, adult disposable diapers, bladder catheters,

electrocautery devices , feeding, antiseptic, oxygenation and sampling probes. This important batch of medical equipment, according to Mayor Adama Diop, was donated by his friends living in the United States of America, collected, conditioned by the charitable section of " Wisconsin Medical Project ". "I wanted to discreetly make this important donation whose value is estimated at 40 million francs. But the American donors have strongly wished to organize a public ceremony so that the national and international opinion are informed of their approach. We spent 5.5 million CFA francs for customs clearance and other fees, "said Mayor Adama Diop. Revealing, moreover, that these benefactors have promised to make these donations twice a year. "(...) Thus, we intend to fully and truly equip the general hospital of Sinfra. And given the large amount of donations, we decided to share them with the other health centers in the commune, "he clarified. Before handing over the samples to the Prefect of Sinfra, Lacina Fofana on behalf of the Departmental Director (DD) of Health and Public Hygiene, Kra Koffi Lazare. Which has indicated that he and his various collaborators will make good use of it for the happiness of the populations. "I rejoice on behalf of the government and the people of Sinfra. I express my sincere thanks to Mayor Diop. I hope this material will be put to good use so that the donor is energized to help further. That this gesture is also a task in our department, "said Prefect Fofana. Not without saying "I take this platform to call for cohesion, union. Because it is in the union that we can succeed together the development of our department, our dear country, Côte d'Ivoire. "
